3. SCOPE

This notice applies to all stevedores providing mooring gangs for ship arrivals and departures at Darwin Port facilities.

4. PREFACE

This Port Notice is issued pursuant to Section 57 of the Ports Management Act.

5. DIRECTION

Mooring gangs must comprise of the number of personnel outlined in Appendix 1.

6. LINES BOATS

Line handling boats are not arranged by the mooring gang providers and must be arranged directly with the lines boat service provider.

7. REVIEW STATEMENT

This direction will be reviewed biennially by the Port Management Officer.
