**Prelude:**

The following is a summary of mandatory controls and corrective actions applicable to the identified risk. All stated corrective actions or safety directions stated below must be complied with to ensure that all known risks are controlled.

The summary has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 39 of the WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS *as in force at 1 July 2008*

**Introduction:**

Darwin Port Corporation (DPC) has been served with a Pollution Abatement Notice in regards controlling discharge of pollutants in storm water entering Darwin Harbour.

As a result of inspections to identify areas where export products could enter the East Arm stormwater drainage system, the area surrounding the Oz Minerals Copper Concentrate storage shed has been identified as potential source.

As a matter of urgency, the following actions are to be undertaken:

- a. Giacci is to remove all items currently stored within 5 metres of the shed.
- b. All Cu residue in the immediate area of the storage shed is to be removed
- c. All storm water drains in the immediate area of the storage shed are to be cleaned. The drains are to be cleaned of all residue product to the discharge point.
- d. Equipment which is covered in Cu dust is to be removed from the area

- e. All water storage containers are to be covered and checked that they are not leaking
- f. A bunded storage area away from all port drainage is to be established to locate necessary equipment
- g. Wheeled vehicles used inside the storage shed are not to be used outside the shed area without a complete clean of the wheels and body of the vehicle
- h. External drains are to be cleaned daily to ensure that no build up of product occurs in these areas.

Giacci are to advice DPC when all the actions will be completed.
