Prelude:

The following is a summary of mandatory controls and corrective actions applicable to the identified risk. All stated corrective actions or safety directions stated below must be complied with to ensure that all known risks are controlled.

The summary has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 39 of the WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS *as in force at 1 July 2008*

Introduction:

Discharge of any matter into the Harbour is a serious offence. All stakeholders at EAW are expected to ensure that no products are allowed into the harbour. If products do enter the Harbour, the environmental reporting system must be followed.

Instruction:

Following the loading of cattle the wharf area used during this process must be cleaned.

Drains, pits, rail tracks or any other area where product could collect must be cleaned following the loading operation.

All lumps etc must be swept up and removed from EAW. .

Urine and wet scum may be hosed from the wharf.

Loading equipment must be cleaned down with product captured and removed from EAW.

Hosing of product including feed or manure into the harbour is strictly prohibited.
