Prelude:

The following is a summary of mandatory controls and corrective actions applicable to the identified risk. All stated corrective actions or safety directions stated below must be complied with to ensure that all known risks are controlled.

Introduction:

The disposal of waste is the responsibility of importers, exporters and stakeholders at Darwin Port Facilities. DPC does not have any ability to accept industrial waste or contaminated waste products. DPC is able to take and dispose of quarantine waste at the scheduled rate of charges.

Instruction:

All generated waste at DPC facilities is to be disposed of by the company responsible for the generation of the waste.

Products such as cattle manure, contaminated bulk ore, clinker lump and waste oil must not be dumped within East Arm. It must be removed from East Arm and disposed of according to environmental guidelines.
