# Main Duties/Responsibilities

- Undertake training to gain a valid Port of Darwin pilot licence and progress through the various grades of licence
- Perform the duties of a pilot to meet the operational demands of the Company.
- Conduct safe and efficient pilotage of vessels in the Port of Darwin through the direct application of high level communication, ship handling skills, local knowledge and general marine expertise.
- Undertake safety training, both updating and familiarisation, and marine emergency training for the Port of Darwin.
- Liaise with Ships' masters, operators, agents, regulatory bodies and providers of marine services concerning shipping in the port.
- Assist in the overall task of port pilotage management, including completion of appropriate documentation in a timely manner.
- Perform non-piloting administration functions to assist in the day to day activities of the port.

- Current NT drivers licence
- Current MSIC.
