Main Duties/Responsibilities

- Train to operate, monitor and record Control Centre facilities, including AIS monitoring, navigation radar, HF/VHF radio, computers and other communication equipment.
- Train to monitor and update shipping schedules, liaise and coordinate with internal and external port stakeholders.
- Plan and co-ordinate the allocation of berths, publish daily shipping forecast and distribute to Port' customers and stakeholders.
- Monitor compliance with environmental and safety legislation and procedures.
- Participate as part of a team to document and implement procedures and systems changes to support new technology and safety management innovations.
- Provide support to the Harbour Control team including roster coverage (12 hour shift 24/7 operations) once a minimum level of on the job proficiency is achieved.

Qualifications (Essential)

- Current Northern Territory drivers' licence
- Current Maritime Security Identification Card, or ability to obtain an MSIC
- Knowledge and understanding of the port of Darwin.

Qualifications (Desirable)

- Master <24M NC (or Master Class 5, Skipper Grade 3)
- Restricted Operators Certificate of Proficiency

Experience

- Significant experience in sea going service, preferably in command
- Sound knowledge in commercial maritime operations
- Experience in the provision of services in a maritime environment

- Well-developed interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to relate professionally, tactfully and effectively at all levels internally and with external stakeholders in order to achieve company outcomes.
